There is a \$25 minimum order as well as a \$20 refundable bin deposit for first-time customers (the green bin is what your food is delivered in). Delivery is free and Goodson has a 100 percent satisfaction guarantee. Not bad!

What kinds of things might be available this winter? They carry local and organic grown meats, cheese, eggs, milk, breads, potatoes, apples, pumpkins, greenhouse produce, locally grown canned or frozen fruits and vegetable and many more specialty products. Local Yokel also buys non-local produce during the off-season.
